A Little About the Blues


Five years ago this May the Tuesday Night Blues "Committee" was sitting on pins and needles, Coming up on Tuesday May 26th would be opening night. Hopefully we had gotten the word out and some people would show up. Still struggling to get sponsors enough to help cover the cost, press releases, an article in the Leader-Telegram, some push from Volume One, advertising in a handful of local & regional publications, mentions on WHYS radio, how to format a newsletter/handout, the questions and problems seemed endless and the answers were amorphous, leading to more questions. What about the weather? What if it rains? What if no one comes?

May 26th arrived, a chilly Tuesday threatening rain, Blue Max was set to perform, but both Howard and Deb were under the weather themselves. Should we cancel? Is this going to be a disaster? 4:30 DMI Sound begins setting up with one eye on the radar. 5:30 and the band arrives and starts to set up, The Bluesmobile and Blues Society tent arrive. 6:00, 9 Degrees Ice Cream and The Weenie Wagon are setting up. It's about 65 degrees and dark. Talking with the band we decide to go with it and start 15 minutes early and try to get the show in in case it rains yet. A sliver of sunlight, a sprinkle of rain and Howard "Guitar" Luedtke & Blue Max fire it up for 150 – 200 people in the seats, AWESOME!!! It's alive! Tuesday Night Blues In Owen Park is alive and rockin'! What a great feeling!

That first season in 2009 it seemed like if it was Tuesday it was threatening rain, but every week more people showed up and the core of folks who show almost every week began to grow! Not a single concert was canceled, although when Deepwater Reunion played on July 21st they only got a couple bars in to the second tune when the sky opened up and it started hailing. While many fled, I couldn't help but grin when 50 or more pulled out rain jackets, umbrellas and sheets of plastic and begged us to wait it out and not fold the show for the night. We hung on for about 45 minutes but finally called it a night. We felt really bad for this wonderful group of musicians who come from Manitowoc, Eagle River, Wisconsin Rapids, Madison and several points in between to play for us, and always succeed in being a hit with our fans here,

That first season we weren't sure we had enough bands to fill the 15 week schedule after it was decided to run from Memorial to Labor Day, We filled the schedule and heard no complaints when Moio Lemon played twice and the Sue Orfield Band played both as them and as the band for Ellen Whyte, That first season was rounded out with The Blues Dogs, The Pumps, Left Wing Bourbon, Lucy Creek, The Love Buzzards, The Tommy Bentz Band, and The Jones Tones as well as a "Young Blues Night" in the middle of the season. All 15 nights were played in Owen Park,

It is our fifth season, starting tonight, again with Howard Luedtke & Blue Max. That is a reason to celebrate. Many of the challenges are the same, and you can throw in a handful more to boot, but we know that you are going to be here. That was the big question mark in 2009, but we believed and you proved us right. Thank You for being here. We now have more bands and performers than we can possibly (continued on back)
