Lead singer Billy Evanochko is widely-known across the Steel City for his impassioned lyrics, seductive vocals, and stinging guitar riffs. Together with his band, The Regulators, they deliver a well-balanced dose of funky rhythm and blues, with heart and soul being the main ingredient. Playing countless clubs and festivals throughout the country, The band attracts fans with their fresh mix and interpretation of the iconic R&B experience.

The band competed with acts from all over the world in Memphis January 22-25, 2014, earning them the 3rd Place Win among the best blues bands in the world! Their Sophomore CD "She Got a Hold on Me", released in April 2012, wowed judges at the 2013 International Blues Challenge in Memphis, TN in which it placed in the top 5 best CD's submitted from around the world for the Best Self Produced CD.

Billy has appeared with & opened for a virtual who's who of modern blues royalty. Billy the Kid and the Regulators continue to write music, and perform cooking up their brand of blues with soul being the main ingredient.

All 3 of these artists recently competed and won awards at The Blues Foundation's International Blues Competition in Memphis. Give them a try, bet you won't be sorry.

## A Little About the Blues

New Artists you will want to check out.

Beale Street's latest success story is Ghost Town Blues Band. Their debut release *Dust the Dust*, (Inside Sounds) has received an impressive amount of airplay throughout the US and Europe. The recording won the European Independent Music Label Award for "Top Sound" in blues. Both Preston McEwen behind the drums and Dusty Sikes on the bass guitar are a punishing rhythm section behind Isbell's raunchy guitar licks and chainsaw rhythms. Newest edition, Dr. Dabbo on keys has plainly made the music go from great to even better as the band gains more notoriety in the blues circuit.

Ghost Town Blues Band is a modern blues band with an intimate knowledge of both blues, rock and improvisational jams. At the same time, the band's raw energy and intensity is reminiscent of some of the best blues that rock n' roll has ever offered. The band can turn on a dime from North Mississippi



hill country grooves to classic electric urban blues and funk. This Memphis-based gritty foursome has been touring the US since its inception in 2009, gaining a strong following within the blues and Jam Band circuit. "GTBB shows what can happen when the past is distilled through young sensibilities, voices, and instruments. This is 21st century blues at its best." - Living Blues Magazine

Castro Coleman a-k-a Mr. Sipp "The Mississippi Blues Child". Born August 25, 1976 to Johnelle and the late Vera Coleman in the small town of McComb, MS. He began playing the guitar at the tender age of 6. Due to hard work and perseverance, Mr. Sipp has become an awesome vocalist, songwriter, musician, composer, producer and entertainer.

Castro has over 125 credits and has played on over 50 national recordings with several Grammy nominated projects. He has traveled to Russia, Germany and other countries spreading his gift of music.

Mr. Sipp is the 2014 International Blues Challenge Winner by way of The Vicksburg Blues Society, 2014 Gibson Best Guitarist Award Winner, 2014 Jus' Blues Bobby Rush Entertainers Award Recipient. Mr. Sipp was also cast in the recently released James Brown movie, "Get on Up". Mr. Sipp's favorite quote, "I'm living to love the life that I live, Music!!!!" (continued on back)

I love entertaining and feel blessed whenever I am able to perform. I know I have been called to a deeper purpose.
