We chose Owen Park to be our venue, that is what the Bandshell was built for and it IS the best outdoor music venue in the city. The acoustics are excellent, the trees provide shade on a hot summer night and the sun is at the backs of the fans. We think the lineup is excellent with a bunch of your favorites playing 2-1/2 to 3 hr sets. There is a reasonable admission, but it includes FREE camping. The venue is set up for music with a covered are including stage and an outdoor bar, right next to a bar & grill with reasonable beverage and home made food. To give you an idea where the money goes, we pay the talent almost on a par with the local bars (actually more than some), both musicians and production. In addition to the application and facility rental fees to the City Parks and Rec. Department, we provide insurance for all of these events. The energy he brings is infectious, An excellent guitar player in his own right, Jeremy has previously been involved with some pretty well known local groups like Snifter and The Front Porch.

Lucas K. Fischer is on Lead Guitar and Vocals for the Rhythm Posse. His influences range from Nine Inch Nails to Blind Willie McTell. In the various projects of which he takes part, he fills multiple roles from drums to bass to rhythm and lead guitar. He's played with Pine Hollow Audio's Motown Tribute and 60's Tribute, a duo with Catya, Boxcar Sojourn with John Nietz and Lucas K. and The Cool Hand Saints. Currently he plays in Looking Glass Down, AcoustiHOO, and Code Blue.

Levi Vaughn Felling played piano as a young kid, then switched to drums in high school and ended up in the rhythm section of the Matt Berry Blues Band, with who, as a teenager, played local bars, clubs, festivals and at the height of it opened for "Asleep at the Wheel" at the State Theater. With the good fortune to have been acquainted with the likes of the Butanes, and many other fine players at a young age, Levi has appeared with Nine Below Zero, Florez-Stanton-

Vaughn, Snifter, and The Resonators and opened for the likes of The Hoopsnakes, Smashmouth, Luther Next Tuesday, we'll be in the final stage of prepping for Sisters.
